I am going to brag! Deacon John Anderson knew my name. He always called me by my first name, "Wanda." I loved this so much.





Keith Lamar Johnson (May 17, 1972 – September 30, 2022), who went by the stage name Wonderboy, was an American gospel singer-songwriter.

In 1998, he started his solo music career with the release of *Through the Storm*, published by World Wide Gospel Records. He released fourteen albums, over the course of thirteen years, with World Wide Gospel Records, Worldwide Records, <u>Verity Records</u>, Central South Records, and Blacksmoke Records.

Eleven albums charted on the <u>Billboard magazine Gospel Albums</u> chart with other chartings on the <u>Independent Albums</u> and <u>Heatseekers Albums</u> charts. His music career started in 1998, with the release of *Through the Storm* by World Wide Gospel Records,^[3] and this would be just one of eleven albums to chart on the <u>Billboard magazine</u> charts, with most of the chartings occurring on the <u>Gospel Albums</u>.^[4] A few placements were on the <u>Independent Albums</u> chart, for 2000's *Live and Alive*, 2001's *Tribute to Quartet Legends, Vol. 1*, and 2002's *Send a Revival*, and those just happen to be the albums that placed on the <u>Heatseekers Albums</u> chart.^[4] The labels he has released albums with are World Wide Gospel, World Wide Records, <u>Verity Records</u>, Central South Records, and Blacksmoke Records, and he has released fourteen albums with those labels over the course of his thirteen-year career.^[3] His backing vocalist and band are called The Spiritual Voices.^[2]

Loretta Lynn (<u>née</u> **Webb**; April 14, 1932 – October 4, 2022) was an American singersongwriter. In a career which spanned six decades in <u>country music</u>, Lynn released multiple gold albums. In 1980, the film <u>Coal Miner's Daughter</u> was made based on her life.



Lynn received many awards and other accolades for her groundbreaking role in country music, including awards from both the <u>Country Music Association</u> and <u>Academy of</u> <u>Country Music</u> as a duet partner and an individual artist. She was nominated 18 times for a <u>Grammy Award</u>, and won three times.^[1] As of 2022, Lynn was the most awarded female country recording artist, and the only female ACM Artist of the Decade (1970s). Lynn scored 24 No. 1 hit singles and 11 number one albums. She ended 57 years of touring on the road after she suffered a stroke in 2017 and then broke her hip in 2018.^[2]

Dame Angela Brigid Lansbury <u>DBE</u> (16 October 1925 – 11 October 2022) was an Irish-British^[2]-American actress and singer who played various roles across film, stage, and television. Her career, one of the longest in the entertainment industry, spanned eight decades, much of it in the United States; her work also received much international attention. She was one of the last surviving stars from the <u>Golden Age of Hollywood cinema</u> at the time of her death

Lansbury received an <u>Honorary Academy Award</u>, a Lifetime Achievement Award from the <u>BAFTA</u>, a <u>Lifetime Achievement Tony Award</u> and five additional <u>Tony</u> <u>Awards</u>, six <u>Golden Globes</u>, and an <u>Olivier Award</u>. She also was nominated for numerous other industry awards, including the <u>Academy Award for Best</u> <u>Supporting Actress</u> on three occasions, and various <u>Primetime Emmy Awards</u> on 18 occasions, and a <u>Grammy Award</u>. In 2014, Lansbury was made a <u>Dame</u> <u>Commander of the Order of the British Empire</u> by <u>Queen Elizabeth II</u>.^[3] She was the subject of three biographies. –Wikipedia
