A LOVING FATHER



Elder Minor Palm, Jr. was born in Detroit, Michigan on February 5, 1926 to his parents: Elder Minor Palm, Sr. and Missionary Marie Palm. He was their only son. They were also blessed with three daughters: Lorraine, Lillian and Katie. The family loved and served the Lord. They were actively involved in church ministries and community work.

He came to the Lord Jesus Christ in November 1946 at Love Tabernacle Church of God in Christ in Detroit, Michigan. The late Elder Willie Rimson was the pastor. Overseer McGlothen from Oakland, California was in charge of this revival.

While Elder Palm was seeking the Lord at the altar, Bishop Charles Harrison Mason, the founder of the Church of God in Christ, came up and anointed everyone at the altar. Elder Palm had a great experience during this time.

He was filled with the Holy Ghost in December of that same year at a revival held at Hartford Street Church of God in Christ. The pastor was the late Bishop U. E. Miller. This revival was run by Mother Young. God called him to preach the gospel in February 1948.

On May 14, 1949 he married Ms. Willie Lee McCann. They have three children, a son-in-law, daughter-in-law, three grandchildren and three

great-grandchildren. His wife, Missionary Willie Palm, went home to be with the Lord in 2002.

Elder Palm was a member of Greater Miller Memorial Church of God in Christ, known as Hartford Street Church of God in Christ. His pastor was Bishop U. E. Miller. In later years, Bishop Earl J. Wright, Sr. became their pastor. Elder Palm served the church in many leadership areas. He was a General Sunday School Superintendent, the founder of "Church on the Rocks" at the Wayne County Jail in Detroit, mission worker, Junior Church pastor, Assistant Bible Teacher to the Bishop and other positions.

He was a graduate of Cass Tech High School. Elder Palm was employed at Cadillac Motors Car Division as a skilled craftsman. He retired in 1980.


All of his life, Elder Palm was involved in music. He was an outstanding and gifted trumpeter. God blessed him to play in numerous gospel bands from 1940-1980.He was a graduate of the Toronto Conservatory of Music and has received numerous musical awards.

He also graduated from the Auto-mechanics School in 1947. He attended and graduated from the Detroit Barber School, Detroit Bible College and Moody Bible Institute under Superintendent Havious Green.

He was an award-winning writer and talented songwriter. He was an esteemed Legendary Author in The Called and Ready Writers in Detroit, Michigan. Dr. Mary Edwards is the founder. Mrs. Wanda J. Burnside serves as the president of this ministry. One of his endeavors was to publish his book of gospel hymns and complete other writing projects. His greatest desire was to continue to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ to every man, women, boy and girl.

In his later years, he founded a special outreach ministry, FEED MY SHEEP MINISTRIES, to touch and change lives through the radio and printed word.


2023 marks the 157th anniversary of Juneteenth, the holiday that recognizes the first day of freedom for enslaved Africans in Texas and commemorates the end of slavery in the United States as a whole.

The Emancipation Proclamation issued by President Abraham Lincoln freed enslaved people in Confederate states in 1863. It was a measure meant to punish the Confederacy during the U.S. Civil War and did not cover enslaved Africans in border states. It also failed to free those held in bondage in Texas. That would not come until June 19, 1865, when Union General Gordon Granger landed in Galveston, Texas, and issued General Order #3. Popular belief is that the enslaved Africans in Texas did not know about the Emancipation Proclamation until Granger's announcement.

There is a Juneteenth flag

The Juneteenth flag is red, white and blue, though it is constructed differently than the red, white, and blue you're used to seeing.

The flag has one bursting star and is the brainchild of activist Ben Haith, founder of the *National Juneteenth Celebration Foundation*. Haith created the flag in 1997 with the help of collaborators, and Boston-based illustrator <u>Lisa Jeanne</u> <u>Graf</u> brought their vision to life.



In 2000, the flag was revised to the version we see today. Seven years later, the date June 19th, 1865 was added to the flag. The lone star represents both Texas, where the last of slaves were freed, and the freeing of slaves in all 50 states.

The curve that extends across the width of the flag represents a new horizon and The red, white and blue represents the American flag, a reminder that slaves and their descendants were and are Americans.

"O send out thy light and thy truth: let them lead me; let them bring me unto thy holy hill, and to thy tabernacles. Then will I go unto the altar of God, unto God my exceeding joy: yea, upon the harp will I praise thee, O God my God."

An Intimate Connection

Over the years, I've heard Christian men and women express their desire to grow in their relationship with God. That is to go deeper in their knowledge of Him and His Word. These words of Jesus are quite sobering. If we think beyond His "I will love him" and really think about this conditional promise, we will want, more than anything, to know Him and to see more of Him. This means for Him to manifest Himself to us. Manifest (emphanizō) means "to show one's self, come into view, and appear."

According to Psych2Go, there are 5 levels of friendship: Strangers ("I know of you"), Acquaintances ("I know you"), Casual Friends ("I like you"), Close Friends ("I understand you"), and Intimate Friends ("I connect with you").

Jesus said He no longer calls us servants but "friends" (John 15:14). This

means "there is no greater love than a man lay down his life for his friends." He came to show us the Father and make Him known. The Bible calls us co-heirs with Christ (Romans 8:17) and we are seated with Christ in the heavenly places (Ephesians 2:6) assuming the power and authority given us.

The more we dig into God's Word, walk in obedience to His precepts and walk in the power of the Holy Spirit, the deeper things of God will be revealed to us. The Holy Spirit is our Teacher, our Guide and our Comforter. As we draw near to God, He will draw near to us and will reveal Himself and we will know (experience) Him (James 4:8)

This is an invitation to a more intimate friendship. Jesus' invitation to a relationship with Him is modeled after His relationship with His Father; they are One in every way (John 10) (one in character, intimacy, connection and power).

It is up to each of us to decide which level of intimacy we want with God. Will you be satisfied with acquaintance, casual, close connection? Or will you seek to know Him intimately?

This takes a commitment on our part; a commitment of time and energy. After all, it is through actively seeking Him in prayer and the study of His Word that we truly gain that sweet knowledge and connection. He promises that when we seek Him with our whole heart, we will find Him (Jeremiah 29:13)



TINA TURNER The "Queen of Rock 'n' Roll

November 26, 1939 – May 24, 2023



Tina Turner (born Anna Mae Bullock;

November 26, 1939 – May 24, 2023) was an American-born singer.^[a] Known as the "<u>Queen</u> <u>of Rock 'n' Roll</u>", she rose to prominence as the lead singer of the <u>Ike & Tina Turner</u> <u>Revue</u> before launching a successful career as a solo performer. She was noted for her "swagger, sensuality, powerful gravelly vocals and unstoppable energy", along with her wellpublicized history with ex-husband <u>Ike</u> <u>Turner</u> and her famous legs.^{[5][6][7]}

Turner began her career with Ike Turner's band <u>Kings of Rhythm</u> in 1957. Under the name Little Ann, she appeared on her first record, "<u>Boxtop</u>", in 1958. In 1960, she debuted as Tina Turner with the hit duet single "<u>A Fool in Love</u>". The duo Ike & Tina Turner became "one of the most formidable live acts in history."^[8] They released hits such as "<u>It's Gonna Work</u>

<u>Out Fine</u>", "<u>River Deep – Mountain High</u>", "<u>Proud Mary</u>", and "<u>Nutbush City Limits</u>", before disbanding in 1976.

In the 1980s, Turner launched "one of the greatest comebacks in music history."⁽²⁾ Her 1984 <u>multi-platinum</u> album <u>Private Dancer</u> contained the hit song "<u>What's</u> <u>Love Got to Do with It</u>", which won the <u>Grammy Award for Record of the Year</u> and became her first and only number-one song on the <u>Billboard Hot 100</u>. At 44, she was the oldest female solo artist to top the Hot 100.⁽¹⁰⁾ Her chart success continued with "<u>Better Be Good to Me</u>", "<u>Private Dancer</u>", "<u>We Don't Need Another Hero</u> (<u>Thunderdome</u>)", "<u>Typical Male</u>", "<u>The Best</u>", "<u>I Don't Wanna Fight</u>", and "<u>GoldenEye</u>". During her <u>Break Every Rule World Tour</u> in 1988, she set a then-<u>Guinness World Record</u> for the <u>largest paying audience</u> (180,000) for a solo performer.

Turner also acted in the films <u>Tommy</u> (1975) and <u>Mad Max Beyond</u> <u>Thunderdome</u> (1985). In 1986, she published her autobiography <u>I, Tina: My Life Story</u>, which was adapted for the 1993 film <u>What's Love Got to Do with It</u>. In 2009, Turner retired after completing her <u>Tina!: 50th Anniversary Tour</u>, which is the <u>15th-highestgrossing tour</u> of the 2000s. In 2018, she became the subject of <u>Tina</u>, a jukebox musical.

Turner has sold more than 150 million records worldwide, becoming one of the <u>best-selling recording artists of all time</u>.^[11] She received 12 <u>Grammy Awards</u>, which include

eight competitive awards, a <u>Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award</u> and three <u>Grammy</u> <u>Hall of Fame</u> inductions. She was the first black artist and first woman to be on the <u>cover of Rolling Stone</u>. <u>Rolling Stone</u> ranked her among the <u>100 Greatest Artists of</u> <u>All Time</u> and the 100 Greatest Singers of All Time. Turner has a star on the <u>Hollywood</u> <u>Walk of Fame</u> and on the <u>St. Louis Walk of Fame</u>. She was inducted into the <u>Rock and</u> <u>Roll Hall of Fame</u> twice, with Ike Turner in 1991 and as a solo artist in 2021. She was also a 2005 recipient of the <u>Kennedy Center Honors</u> and <u>Women of the Year award</u>.^[12]

Cathy Lynn Gravitt Mink went to her eternal home on Sunday, May 7, 2023.

She was born on November 3, 1947 in Lexington, KY, to Billy Cassius Gravitt and Margaret Adair Gravitt. She was sister to Gary Cassius Gravitt (Judy) and Robert Kent Gravitt (Linda) and aunt to Amanda Gravitt Rogers.

Cathy married Leonard "Len" Myers Mink, Jr. on June 18, 1972. They have two children, Carrie Meredith Mink Perez (Omar) and Leonard "Lenny" Myers Mink III (Leslie) and six beautiful grandchildren: Sydney Mercedes Mink, Leonard "Leo" Myers Mink IV, Dominic Antonio Perez, Stone Cassius Mink, Dylan Antonio Perez, and Violet Ruth Mink. From Lexington, Cathy's family moved to Washington, DC from 1949 until 1957 for her father's law career. They briefly came back to Lexington and then settled in Cincinnati, Ohio where she attended Finneytown High School. Cathy went on to graduate from The Ohio State University where she obtained her degree in teaching. She modeled throughout her high school and college years and then professionally with the Ford Agency in New York City. She returned to Cincinnati and taught English for a year at Mason High School.

Cathy met Len while he was in production of his musical variety television broadcast, "The Len Mink Show." They were married in 1972 and left behind modeling and show business to start their ministry - a ministry that has circled the globe for over 50 years. During those years they were honored to work with Kenneth Copeland Ministries for 42 years with Len leading worship and Cathy assisting in Healing School.

She also fulfilled a lifelong dream by graduating from Rhema Bible College in 1996, founded by her father in the faith, Kenneth E. Hagin.

They launched their daily television show, "Len and Cathy," on the TCT Network, seen in the U.S. on DirecTV, and around the world in 173 countries.


They have enjoyed a long-time relationship with the Oasis Radio Network, reaching millions of listeners worldwide. Through all of this amazing media ministry, they have continued to travel around the world over nine million miles, visiting 58 countries.

PAT ROBERTSON

May 22, 1930 – June 8, 2023



Perhaps best known for offering prayer and political commentary at the helm of *The 700 Club*, the flagship program of his media ministry, Robertson's rise to prominence is rooted in what he called a vision from God to create The Christian Broadcasting Network, which he founded in 1960. A prolific innovator, he also started a Christian university, a legal advocacy group, and an international NGO specializing in disaster relief.

Even while promoting a worldview that believes in the inerrancy of the Bible, both his approach to business and his on-air persona were considered unorthodox by some – if not ahead of his time. Today, his influence and legacy crisscross interests and industries that have broken barriers for countless Christian leaders and laypeople.

Born Marion Gordon Robertson in Lexington, Virginia on March 22, 1930, the nickname "Pat" was given to him by his older brother. Sticking with that moniker rather than his birth name was just the first of many conventions he would defy during his lifetime.






