

A BIBLICAL LOOK AT RITUALS

DON'T FROWN ON SOME RITUALS and TRADITIONAL PRACTICES. The Bible is filled with rituals and practices for blessings from Genesis to Revelation. They were based upon the godly or God-ordained or God-ordered commandments for the people of God. Then we find that there are ungodly practices or rituals that were done by people and nations who were against God.

Let us consider a very godly man in the Bible, named Job. The Bible states that Job was upright, good, just, honest and served God. He was a true Worshipper. He was a devoted and loving family man, too.

“There was a man named Job, living in the land of Uz,^[a] who worshiped God and was faithful to him. He was a good man, careful not to do anything evil. ²He had seven sons and three daughters, ³and owned seven thousand sheep, three thousand camels, one thousand head of cattle, and five hundred donkeys. He also had a large number of servants and was the richest man in the East” (Job 1:1-3 GNT).

Now, we can say clearly Job was, “BLESSED and HIGHLY FAVORED.” God had given Job many wonderful and glorious New Years! Job was super-blessed! He was rich, successful and he had it all. NO WORRIES and PROBLEMS for JOB! He was BLESSED!

JOB HAD A RITUAL

So, here we are in a NEW YEAR and want blessings in abundance in our lives. We would love to be rich and successful like Job. The Bible tells us that he was good, faithful, a worshipper, and careful not to do anything evil. Right there are some of the major keys for his blessed life. We should practice living this way, too.

However, this was not all that Job did to make sure that he and his family were blessed by God. He had a daily ritual that he did. The Bible states:

“Job’s sons used to take turns giving a feast, to which all the others would come, and they always invited their three sisters to join them. ⁵The morning after each feast, Job would get up early and offer sacrifices for each of his children in order to purify them. He always did this because he thought that one of them might have sinned by insulting God unintentionally,” (Job 1:4-5 GNT).

Job wanted to make sure that the blessings of the Lord would continue in his life and in the life of his children. So, every morning he got up early and offered a special offering or sacrifice for each one of his children. He did this to purify them or set them free from wrong doings or sayings against God.

God honored Job for what he did. God smiled upon Job. He had the favor of God on his life. Job was highly esteemed of God.

WHAT? WHY?

God was so pleased about the wonderful things that Job did. God was so proud of how he worshipped Him, took care of his family and did all that he could to make sure that there was no sin or evil stuff going on in his house! He strived to live holy before God.

Well, the Bible tells us how Satan was watching Job, too. Satan had been going here and there throughout the earth and then...he stopped and looked at the way that Job lived and how he was so blessed. (Job 1: 7 GTL).

God bragged about Job. He asked Satan if he considered how blessed Job was in the earth. God wanted to make sure that Satan got a good look at a good and godly man. Then their conversation changed and Satan was ready to try making Job's life miserable, so he would hate God for his troubles.

"Did you notice my servant Job?" the LORD asked. "There is no one on earth as faithful and good as he is. He worships me and is careful not to do anything evil."

⁹ Satan replied, "Would Job worship you if he got nothing out of it? ¹⁰ You have always protected him and his family and everything he owns. You bless everything he does, and you have given him enough cattle to fill the whole country. ¹¹ But now suppose you take away everything he has—he will curse you to your face!"

¹² "All right," the LORD said to Satan, "everything he has is in your power, but you must not hurt Job himself. So Satan left" (Job 1:8-12).

SATAN ATTACKS JOB

Readers, this is the part in the Bible that has always troubled me because God points out Job to Satan. God makes sure that Satan notices Job. I mean what a place for Job to be in! There is Almighty God telling Satan how good Job is. Then this stirs up Satan to attack Job so that Job would "curse God to His face!" (vs.11). God gave Satan an offer that he could not refuse.

Immediately Satan rages a war against Job. Great devastation and massive destruction comes right at Job. His entire life is an immense nightmare!

- The Sabeans attacked and stole all Job's donkeys. They killed all of the servants except one. (Job 1:13-15 GNT)
- Suddenly, lightning struck his sheep and shepherds and killed them all except one. (Job 1:16)
- Next, three bands of Chaldean raiders attacked his other servants, took away the camels, and killed all his servants except one. (Job 1:17)
- Right then, another servant came and said, *"Your children were having a feast at the home of your oldest son, when a storm swept in from the desert. It blew the house down and killed them all. I am the only one who escaped to tell you" (Job 1:18 GNT).*

WHAT DID JOB DO?

Satan caused all of this! He killed! He wiped out Job's fortune, property, business, and his family! How horrible! Mass destruction!

However, the Bible said:





²²In spite of everything that had happened, Job did not sin by blaming God" (Job 1:20-22 GNT).

And still he holds fast to his integrity, although you incited Me against him, to destroy him without cause.'" (Job 2:2-3 NKJV).

JOB SUFFERED







"So Satan answered the LORD and said, "Skin for skin! Yes, all that a man has he will give for his life. ⁵ But stretch out Your hand now, and touch his bone and his flesh, and he will surely curse You to Your face!"

⁶ And the LORD said to Satan, "Behold, he is in your hand, but spare his life."

⁷ So Satan went out from the presence of the LORD, and struck Job with painful boils from the sole of his foot to the crown of his head. ⁸ And he took for himself a potsherd with which to scrape himself while he sat in the midst of the ashes" (Job 2:4-8 NKJV).



On top of all of Job's miseries, his wife turned against him and God. She told Job to curse God and die! (Job 2:9) She had no compassion and concern for Job. She raged in anger.



Job's friends did not encourage him or comfort him in his time of suffering. They were critical and very fault-finding about all of his trials. They blamed Job for what had happened to him. (Job 4 and Job 8)



Each day Job got weaker and unable to do many things. He could hardly move.

From LONGSUFFERING to BLESSINGS

Job was really tested on every level of his life. He was a highly-prized servant of God. Job lived right and did all that he could do to stay blessed. He did a daily ritual of prayers and offerings to God to prevent evil from getting into his life.

Job was like each one of us who strives to live right or holy. We desire to have overflowing blessings from the Lord. We don't want a day, year or life with loss, sickness, deaths, poverty and torment. We sure don't want our spouse continuously arguing and complaining at us. We don't need friends who blame us for the troubles or misfortunes that life brings.

The Bible lets us know that Job's attacks came from a deal between God and Satan. Satan wanted to prove that Job would not serve God if he had trouble in his life. However, God knew Job's heart and He was confident that nothing that Satan would do could shake Job's faith in God.

No matter how long the tests were from Satan against Job, he did not quit believing and trusting in God! Job did not curse out God for the horrible things going on! Even when his friends came against him, Job did not fight back! Instead, Job prayed for them. When Job prayed blessings and kindness on them, THAT IS WHEN HIS TROUBLES ENDED!

"After Job had prayed for his friends, the LORD restored his fortunes and gave him twice as much as he had before" (Job 42:10 NIV).

God gave Job twice of everything that was taken from him by Satan!

"So the LORD blessed Job in the second half of his life even more than in the beginning. For now he had 14,000 sheep, 6,000 camels, 1,000 teams of oxen, and 1,000 female donkeys. And he also had seven sons and three daughters" (Job 42:12-13 NIV).


.....However, at the same time, instead of praying, there were those in New York's Times Square who celebrated by watching "the ball

Cold Weather. Warm Heart

It was a cold blistery day in December. One of those days when all I wanted to do was stay in bed under the nice warm covers. But I had already hit the snooze alarm once and I knew if I hit it again, I would be late for work. So, I pulled myself out of bed and headed for the job.

Riding down the street, I saw a very strange site and asked our driver to go around the block, which he did. That's when I saw him: a nicely-dressed man with clean jeans, new-looking Timberland boots, a zip-up sweater, and holding the collar close to his neck as you would if you were cold. He was also wearing a nice gold watch and rings on each finger. The reason I could see his clothing is that HE HAD ON NO COAT! We knew something was wrong. I told the driver to pull over.

I got out of the truck and asked the man standing there if he was okay. (Not a very bright question, considering the weather and his appearance. It was about 20 degrees outside.) When he didn't respond, I asked, "*What's your name?*" He quickly responded with his first and last name. "*Are you lost?*" Still there was no response. "*Do you need to use a phone?*" I asked. He

nodded. When I asked him his number, he said he didn't have his card. I knew then he had a situation.

With his non-helpful answers and my observations, I instructed him to get in our vehicle. Chris, our driver, quickly dialed up the heat and gave John his own gloves to put on to help in the warming process. Again, I asked John his name to make sure his response was the same. He quickly replied with the same name. His responses still were not useful. Even so, putting him out of the truck and leaving him on the street was not an option. So I exited the vehicle to flag down a couple of cars as Chris positioned the truck properly. We had parked on the wrong side of the street when we approached John. I exited the truck and asked a couple of cars driving by if they knew our lost friend. They didn't, but after I explained the situation, they were mutually concerned.

While we were still there trying to figure out what to do, a lady walked up. We asked if she knew the man. To no avail, she didn't know our friend either. Another concerned lady stopped. She didn't know John either. With those two ladies still on the site, a third person approached the intersection. I flagged him down. Again, I asked, "Do you know the guy in the truck? To everyone's amazement the driver said, *"That's John. I haven't seen him in three years!!"* So, I asked, "Do you know where he lives? With certainty, he replied, *"Yeah, down the street."*

That's when we realized a miracle had just taken place. Within a five-minute span of time and stopping three people to see if they knew John, we preceded to follow the guy to John's house with John still in our custody.

We arrived at the house, which was on the same street where we discovered John, Sorrento and Six Mile Road. It was A HALF MILE AWAY! John had walked a very long way in the cold without a coat!

We knocked on the door, while John remained in the truck. After several knocks on the door, it was answered. I asked, *"Do you know the guy over there in the truck?"* He said, *"Yes. That's my brother. He has Alzheimer."* The resident appeared to be under the influence of a negative substance, hadn't missed John, showed no concern, and didn't ask any questions. Not even a "thank you." I asked him to tell me our friend's name and he replied correctly.

We released John, wished him well, and left. Needless to say, it bothered us. But there didn't seem to be anything else we could do but let him enter the house. One consolation is that we got him out of the elements on a very cold day.
