

In this article, that photo next to me is my sweet baby sister, Regina Morna Palm. I miss her so much. She passed in 2017. I think about her every day.



She also sang songs to others who were hurting, sorrowful, depressed, brokenhearted, and in great despair. I was always blessed by her singing. One of her favorite songs was, *"Take My Hand, Precious Lord."* It was written by Thomas A. Dorsey.

Thomas A. Dorsey is credited with publishing over 400 jazz and blues songs and composed hundreds more. Mr. Dorsey's most famous composition, "Precious Lord, Take My Hand" was composed during the grief he suffered after his first wife, Nettie Harper, died during childbirth and his first son, Thomas Andrew Jr., died two weeks later. This horrific event coupled with several nervous breakdowns where he contemplated suicide led to Dorsey committing himself entirely to gospel music and the Lord's work.






Gary McSpadden January 26, 1943 - April 15, 2020

Pastor Gary McSpadden was an American pastor, singer, songwriter, producer, television host and motivational speaker. He had musical roots in quartet music and Southern gospel with The Statesmen, The Oak Ridge Boys, The Imperials, The Bill Gaither Trio, and The Gaither Vocal Band. McSpadden's songs include "Jesus Lord To Me", "Hallelujah Praise

The Lamb", and "No Other Name But Jesus". He has produced albums for numerous groups.

In 1987, he co-hosted PTL Today after Jim Bakker resigned. McSpadden went on to produce television programs, including the "Jubilee" concert series filmed at Silver Dollar City in Branson, Missouri. He also produced and starred in several live music shows in the Branson area during the 1990s and 2000s.

He was married for many years to his wife Carole. They have children and grandchildren.



Walter Clayton Mills Jr.

JULY 14, 1936 - MARCH 2, 2020

Walt was born July 14, 1936 in Dallas, Texas to Clayton and Pauline Mills. He married the love of his life, Betty Feemster, on October 18, 1952 and they had 67 happy years together. He went to Bible College in Waxahachie and began a long career as an evangelistic minister and gospel singer. Walt and Betty had their own television programs, "Revivals in the Land" on TBN and "Behold the Glory" on

TCT, both of which aired for over 20 years.

Walt had a passion for music and played both the guitar and banjo. He also recorded with three major music companies and made approximately 20 recordings. His accomplishments include being a published author, writing the song "I'm on My Way to Heaven" which was made popular by Jimmy Swaggart, also "Holy Spirit Flow Through Me" made popular by Benny Hinn, being named artist of the decade in 1993 by ICGMA, and being inducted into the ICGMA Hall of Fame, as well as the Texas Southern Gospel Music Hall of Fame.

Walt touched many lives with his ministry and music. His dedication to his faith and family will be remembered for generations to come. He will be missed by all who knew him.

Doris Homan's Pita Bread



6 cups flour (can use bread flour or regular) 1 tsp salt 2 tbsp yeast 2 tsp sugar 1/2 cup warm water 2 cups warm water (but add as needed)

In a large bowl, mix the salt into the flour. Put the yeast and sugar in a 1/2 cup warm water, stir well to dissolve then let sit till it bubbles (keep eye on it because it will

bubble over). Then add it to the flour and mix.

Keep adding more warm water to the flour as you mix it (till dough is no longer sticky). Knead it a few times, cover with a towel and let it sit in the bowel for about 1 hour, preferably in a warm place (it should almost double in size). Knead it again and let it sit another 20 minutes or so.

Make into dough balls then roll them on a floured surface (big or small depending on the size of loaves you desire) Rub bottom of cookie sheet with olive oil.

Bake at 450 degrees for 6-8 minutes •


Get your music ready! For day or night attacks when you got to prove to the devil that he has to move on! Get out! We must rebuke any and all attacks....in the name of Jesus!


